Break the Glass for an advantage on the hole





SBAC UPDATE



Chicago Small Business Package

The Small Business Advocacy Council (SBAC) is pushing for critical reforms to streamline the process of starting and expanding businesses in Chicago. These reforms aim to cut through the red tape and reduce costs, ultimately fostering economic growth and revitalizing neighborhoods. Key proposals include simplifying zoning requirements, improving process efficiency, and enhancing communication with business owners. By advocating for these changes, we hope to create a more business-friendly environment that allows local entrepreneurs to thrive and contribute to Chicago's economic development.

Illinois Businesses Opening Doors for the Formerly Incarcerated

Illinois has enacted new legislation that increases the tax credit for businesses hiring formerly incarcerated individuals, raising the allowable credit from 5% to 15% of qualified wages and boosting the incentive cap from \$1,500 to \$7,500. This law aims to ease the transition of these individuals into the workforce and provide on-the-job training, ultimately benefiting the Illinois economy by reducing recidivism costs and generating long-term tax revenue. The program, passed by the Illinois General Assembly and signed by Governor Pritzker, is a significant win for small businesses, fostering opportunities for formerly incarcerated individuals, enhancing public safety, and supporting economic growth. With \$1,000,000 allocated to this program, small businesses should start exploring these opportunities now.

Child Care

The SBAC has been actively working on legislation aimed at supporting Illinois families through tax credits. One of the key legislative successes is the passage of HB4951, which establishes a Child Tax Credit in Illinois. This legislation provides additional tax relief for working families with low to moderate incomes, particularly those with children under 12 years old. Eligible taxpayers who receive the Illinois Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) will now be able to claim a Child Tax Credit worth 20% of their EITC for the 2024 tax year, increasing to 40% for the 2025 tax year and beyond. This measure is designed to help alleviate the financial burdens faced by families with young children, making Illinois the 12th state in the nation to implement such a tax credit.


